



Code of Practice – Access & Equity

Effective 1st November 2003

Our Code of Practice states that it is our aim is to provide all persons who wish to become an apprentice plumber the opportunity to do so, if practicable.

The exemption to this is:

Plumbing, Draining and Gasfitting requires those conducting the work to be capable of unimpeded movement and/or actions in places or circumstances that may have inherent dangers. Such as trenches, Working at Heights, In confined Spaces etc. This recruitment is accessed by a qualified medical practitioner during a prevocational medical assessment.
